The Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program is a federally administered program that provides money to low-income aged, blind, and disabled individuals for food, clothing, and shelter. By the end of 2011, 8.1 million Americans were receiving payments under the SSI program, with six in 10 recipients suffering from a mental disorder, according to the U.S. Social Security Administration (SSA).
