



Retired Army Colonel Joins Tully Rinckey PLLC as Chief Operating Officer

Pfeiffer also served as the Commander of the 1st Battalion 127th Armor. During the aftermath of the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, he led his battalion in New York City as they provided critical site security of the World Trade Center wreckage site.

Pfeiffer has received numerous awards for his service to the country, including the Bronze Star, the Iraqi Campaign Medal, the Army Meritorious Service Medal and the Humanitarian Service Medal.

Pfeiffer holds both a bachelor’s degree in criminal justice and a master’s of business administration from Niagara University. Additionally, he was selected to attend the prestigious U.S. Army War College, where he earned a second master’s degree in strategic studies.

His military education includes the Armor Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, the Army Combined Arms Services and Staff School, and the Army Command and General Staff College.
