

DWI / DWAI / ADWI

Being arrested for drunk driving does not automatically mean you are guilty of a crime. DWAI/Combination

Combination of drug and alcohol impairment

Chemical Test Refusal

Refusal to take a chemical test (e.g. breath, blood, urine)

Zero Tolerance Law

Driver under 21 years of age with a 0.02% BAC to 0.07% BAC

BAC: Blood Alcohol Content
