

Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)

Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits are primarily for individuals who have worked for a number of years and paid into the Social Security system, but they can no longer do so because of a disability. Generally, to qualify for SSDI benefits, people must have worked for at least five of the last 10 years. Their earning history will largely dictate the amount of the benefits they receive. Benefits such as workers' compensation may also influence SSDI benefit amounts. Under special circumstances, workers' surviving disabled spouses and disabled adult children may also be eligible for SSDI benefits.
