Beginnings

After escaping from the terrorist attacks, he relocated to New York's Catskill Mountains, where he in 2003 started his law practice out of the back bedroom of his ski home. Prior to pursuing a career in law, Mr. Tully served as an Army field artillery officer and a federal law enforcement officer for the U.S. Department of Justice's Bureau of Prisons.

Initially, Mr. Tully's clients included family, friends, and co-workers primarily in the areas of criminal defense, employment law, civil litigation and real estate law. Owing to his commitment to providing quality and affordable legal services, Mr. Tully's client roster grew and his practice outgrew his Hunter, N.Y. ski home.

In 2004, Greg T. Rinckey, a fellow Army veteran, joined Mr. Tully in establishing a law firm in Albany, N.Y. Mr. Rinckey partnered with Mr. Tully shortly after being honorably discharged from the Army, where he served six years in the Judge Advocate General's (JAG) Corps. There he served as an Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia and as a criminal defense attorney with the Army's Trial Defense Service and Defense Appellate Division. For his military service, he received the Meritorious Service Medal.

In 2005, Tully & Associates, PLLC became Tully Rinckey & Associates, PLLC. The firm changed its moniker again in 2008 to Tully Rinckey PLLC, prompted by the addition of new partners and the opening of a Washington, D.C. office. At its state-of-the-art Albany headquarters near Albany International Airport, Tully Rinckey PLLC established a full-service law firm, where attorneys can meet any legal needs that clients may encounter throughout their lives.
