

## Sexual Offenses

Sex crimes can severely damage a person's reputation and have long-lasting consequences. With convictions of some sexual offenses such as rape and sexual assault, offenders may have to register as sexual offenders – a classification that can severely limit where he or she works and lives. Depending on the nature of the sexual offense, whether it was a felony or misdemeanor, and the age of the victim, an offender could end up facing imprisonment, registration as a sex offender, fines, mandatory rehabilitation, and the loss of certain rights. Generally sexual offenses include the following: Rape

: Forcefully engaging in sexual intercourse without consent.

### Sexual Assault

: Engaging in sexual activity that is both forceful and nonconsensual, including intercourse, molestation and touching.

### Statutory Rape

: Engaging in intercourse with someone who is unable to consent due to age or other legal incapacity.

### Solicitation

: Requesting or encouraging sexual services in exchange for money.

### Child Abuse

: Includes molestation, indecent exposure, child pornography, and other crimes.

### Internet Sex Crimes

: Crimes involving underage victims and committed over the Web, such as solicitation, stalking, child pornography, and endangering the welfare of a child.
