

Copyrights

A copyright is a bundle of rights held in an original work of authorship, including the right to copy, perform, distribute, publicly display, adapt, broadcast, and translate the work. Copyright includes many forms of expression, such as paintings, photographs, manuscripts, movies, sound recordings, videos, and films. Infringement occurs when someone copies, displays, adapts, or broadcasts, etc. the work without the copyright owner's permission in violation of applicable copyright laws. If this occurs, the copyright owner should take steps to prevent further infringement and obtain compensation from the copyright infringer. While in the United States and 165 countries around the world copyright protection is automatic at the moment the work is fixed in a tangible form of expression, in order to fully protect the original work and provide certain protections and remedies against an infringer, registration of the work with the U.S. Copyright Office, and any applicable foreign governmental equivalent, is crucial.
