For claimants to receive SSDI benefits, they must satisfy the SSA's definition of "disability," which says a worker "must not be able to engage in any substantial gainful activity (SGA) because of a medically-determinable physical or mental impairment(s)." The impairment(s) must be life-threatening or must have lasted or be expected to last for at least a continuous 12-month period. Almost a third of SSD beneficiaries suffer from musculoskeletal system or connective tissue impairments. Other impairments common to SSDI beneficiaries include mood disorder impairments, cardiovascular system impairments, mental disorders, and neoplasm impairments.
