

Special Education Law

Children with disabilities are entitled to a free and appropriate public education that takes into consideration their special needs. These rights are provided under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). Parents should expect public schools to prepare their special needs children for future employment and education and living independently. Parents should not let schools get away with providing their special needs children with a sub-par education. For a child to be eligible for special education services, he or she must undergo an independent evaluation procedure (IEP) to determine whether such services would be meaningfully beneficial.
